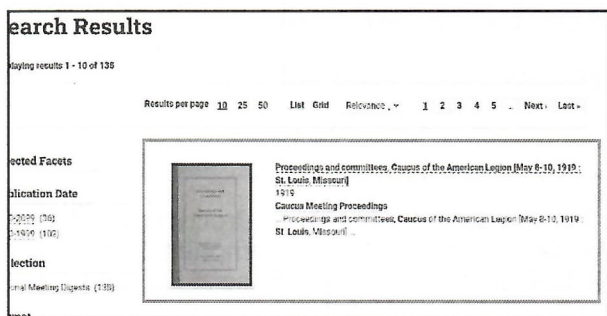

Find Digital Material

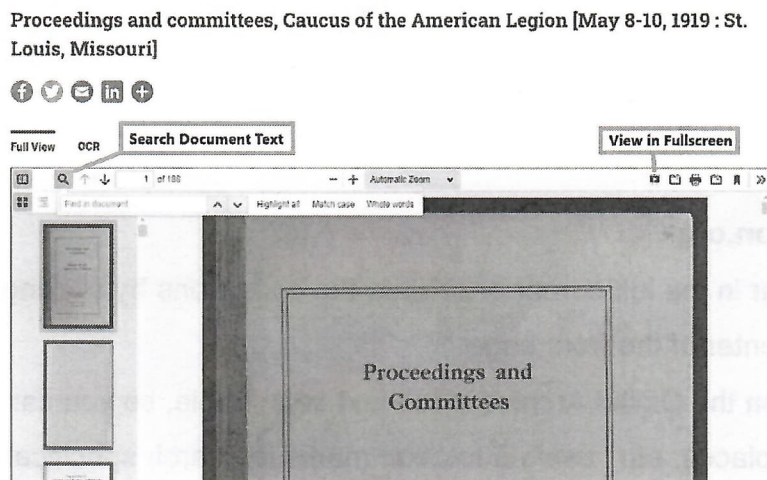
- Visit archive.legion.org.
- Use the search bar in the left corner or browse the collections by clicking on one of the headings in the center of the front page.
- Every document on the Digital Archive is full-text searchable, so you can search for individuals, meeting dates or places, etc., using quotation marks to search specifically.
- Example: To find proceedings from the St. Louis Caucus in May 1919, select National Meetings Digests from the drop down and search for St. Louis Caucus.

Access Digital Material

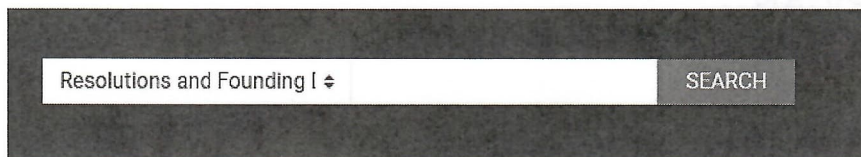
1. Once you've located an item you wish to view, click on the title or on the thumbnail image.



2. Item page includes an item viewer and a short description of the item. Some of the item viewer features include search text, change layout, zoom, and view in full screen.



3. To find current policies of The American Legion, visit the "Resolutions and Founding Documents" collection. Use search facets to narrow results by date and topic.
